# From the Pastor's Office

# The Season of Advent is Now

You may be thinking, "Doesn't Advent start

on the Sunday closest to November 30th?" According to one definition and the traditional church calendar, you would be right. But Advent has another meaning: the coming of a notable person. There is no one more notable than Jesus, and we are waiting for His return.

The first Sunday in Advent is the first Sunday of the church year. As we near the end of the church year, the Biblical texts read in church will focus on the end of the age—meaning the end of this life as we know it.

This can seem scary to some, especially for those who are familiar with the *Left Behind* book series or with those interpretations of eschatology (the study of last things). It's difficult for us in the West, especially in America, where we have enjoyed freedom of religion and speech for so long—although this is changing in Europe and seems to be heading in the same direction in America.

In other parts of the world, Christians are more familiar with persecution and spiritual darkness. They have an easier time understanding that we are already living in the last times, as Jesus spoke of when He was here and as the apostles exhort all of their readers to understand. Here, we've become inoculated to spiritual darkness because our lives have been so easy.

When reading through the book of Revelation and other prophetic books in the Bible, it is important to remember how Jesus fulfills those prophecies. Most of them have already been fulfilled in Christ—by His virgin birth, death on the cross, and resurrection.

Many are in process—they are already happening now and have been for over 2,000 years, during the age we are in now, the Church Age. There are some that are yet to come. Sometimes, it can be difficult to distinguish between those that are in process and those that are yet to come. Let's not get caught up on this, instead our focus should always be on the same subject that it was for the prophets who wrote the material. The main subject, of course, is Jesus Christ, our Lord.

He is the author and finisher of our faith. He is the one who upholds us in our faith. He comforts us by sending the Holy Spirit to guide and direct us. The Holy Spirit Himself is a down payment and proof that we will soon rise again from the dead, just as He did. He will return to earth from heaven in glory and usher us into that resurrection. We will regain (or continue to have) our earthly bodies, but they will be made new as mortality puts on immortality. We will have everlasting life, free from the corruption of sin. Our experience will be like nothing before—different from Adam and Eve in the garden, and vastly different from what we experience now. That is exciting to think about, is it not?

We can make the best of the time we have left because the time is short. We can serve our neighbors and preach the gospel because they need Jesus. We can live as though it's Advent all year long!

At the end of the book of Revelation, John writes about Jesus' testimony regarding His return and says,

"He who testifies to these things says, 'Surely I am coming soon.' Amen. Come, Lord Jesus! The grace of the Lord Jesus be with all. Amen."


